Dear Colleagues:

It is my pleasure to welcome you as a Representative to the 2004-2005 Legislative Assembly of the Academic Senate. As you have been previously informed, the first meeting of the 2004-05 Assembly will be held by teleconference on Wednesday, November 10, 2004 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

The first order of business will be President Dynes' address to the Assembly, followed by a Q/A session. The Assembly will also hear reports from the Board of Admissions and Relations with Schools (BOARS), the University Committee on Faculty Welfare (UCFW) and from the Academic Council's Special Committee on the National Labs (ACSCONL). Action items will include a request from the University Committee on Educational Policy to amend Senate Regulation 544 on concurrent enrollment and to rescind Senate Regulation 630b, which grants an exception to Engineering students for the Senior Residency Requirement.

Campus Senates will be reserving meeting rooms where their Assembly representatives can gather to participate in the teleconference meeting. Information about the campus meeting locations and dial-in information will be sent out next week.
