RE: Allowing "Local Context" for Online California High Schools

Dear Mary,

The Board of Admissions and Relations with Schools (BOARS) has unanimously approved a proposal from Graduate, Undergraduate and Equity Affairs (GUEA) to allow "local context" participation for online California high schools so that graduates of such schools may have the same opportunities for access to UC's guarantee of admission as students attending brick and mortar schools. Although the number of graduates from online California high schools that meet UC Eligibility in the Local Context (ELC) participation standards (i.e., accreditation and offering the minimum 15 A-G courses) is currently small (note enclosure), we expect these numbers to increase. The data show students from these online schools are successful at the University, and their eligibility for admission should be facilitated.
