Dear Robert,

The San Diego campus has submitted a proposal to establish a seventh undergraduate college. Per the Compendium, CCGA is asked to review proposals for new schools and colleges within the University.

From the Compendium:

Establishing a new school or college is a two-step process and takes at least two years to complete. At least one year before submitting a full proposal, proponents of the new school must submit a pre-proposal first to the Divisional Academic Senate, and, if approved, subsequently to the systemwide Academic Senate and to system-level Administration. Upon receipt by the systemwide Senate, the pre-proposal is reviewed by CCGA, UCEP, and the University Committee on Planning Budget (UCPB) as well as by any other systemwide standing committee selected by the Academic Council Chair.

CCGA has reviewed the proposal and approved it. The committee looks forward to seeing the development of this college on the San Diego campus.
